
SUBJECT: Hyundai / Kia oil filter application

## Bulletin No: 13.9.4

Hyundai and Kia applications with oil coolers sandwiched between the filter mounting base and the oil filter may exhibit oil leakage from the oil cooler. Vehicles with oil coolers are:

Oil leakage may occur if the oil cooler center bolt should loosen (see image above). This is possible after multiple filter changes. This may result in oil leakage incorrectly diagnosed as a filter leak. Consult with Hyundai/Kia Dealer or Service Manual for proper repair and installation instructions if center bolt is loose.

Filters should be installed at 2/3 to 1 turn after gasket contact has been made with the filter sealing surface (see image above). Less than 2/3 turns may result in an insufficient seal between the filter and the oil cooler.
